### 1. COMPETITIONS

4<sup>th</sup> round of the Alpe Adria Oldtimer Championship in the following classes:

### **5. RACE OFFICE**

The Race Office is located in the main tower at the start-finish line, entrance from the paddock side.

### 6. APPLICATIONS

Deadline for applications: August 01, 2025 (Sunday) at 24:00

Applications (for races) will be accepted Friday at the secretariat of the race. The entry fee must be paid in cash when submitting the application.

### 7. ENTRY FEES:

200€ euro Per rider/per class

### 8. SERVICE BOXES

Service box reservations.

Fee for the double service box: 200€ (for 2 days: Friday after 12:00/Saturday/Sunday at the end of the event).

Boxes are lockable.

### 9. TRACK

The competition will be held at **Transilvania Motor Ring.** 

• Track length: 3708 meters

• Track width: 12 meters

• Driving direction: **clockwise** (see detailed map in the annex)

### **10. PRACTICE AND RACES**

**Qualifying sessions** and **races** will be grouped as follows:

- Classic
- Oldtimer

**Free practice** will be organized on **08.08.2025** (Friday) — see the schedule.

Applications and payments for free practice must be made through the event registration form.

No administrative check or technical inspection is required for free practice, **however**, technical standards such as **noise level limits** apply, as specified in the 2025 Regulations.

#### 11. START PROCEDURE

All races will follow the **standard 15-minute starting procedure**.

**Exception**: for the **Classic** classes:

- Pit lane opens for **2 minutes**
- Riders perform one sighting lap, then take starting positions without turning off engines
- Once all riders are positioned, the **starter activates red lights**
- When the red lights go out, the race starts



**No warm-up lap** for this shortened procedure.

### **12. RACE DISTANCES**

### **13. TECHNICAL INSPECTION**

Technical inspections will take place in the **box to the right of the Race Office**, near the **paddock entrance**, at times indicated in the official schedule.

Riders must appear with:

- A completed and signed Technical Card
- Their racing suit, back protector, and a certified helmet

At the same location, **motorcycle noise tests** will be conducted. Allowed noise levels are defined in **Section 2.1.23** of the 2025 Regulations. Random **dynamic noise tests** will also occur during the event.

The **Parc Fermé** will be located in a place designated by the Organizer. **Only the rider** and **one mechanic with a motorcycle stand** are allowed to enter.

### 14. TIMING DEVICES (TRANSPONDER)

During qualifying and races, each rider is required to **mount a GPS tracker** on the motorcycle.

50 euro deposit for transponder. Returnable after you bring back the transponder.

Penalties for non-compliance:


- If a device is **damaged or lost**:
  - Transponder: 150 EUR (net)
- Failure to use the correct mounting bracket (available for purchase at the Race Office) is also penalized

If a device is returned **after the event**, a **late return fee of 50 EUR (net)** per device will be charged.

### **15. FUEL**

There is **no fuel available** for purchase on-site.

The **nearest fuel station (ROMPETROL)** is located in **Ungheni**, on **Principala Street**, about **10 km from the main gate**.



### **16. RACES**

Riders who place **in the top 3** of each race **must immediately** submit their motorcycles for **technical inspection** at the location indicated by the Organizer.

**Award ceremonies** will take place **immediately after** the end of the day.

The **podium** is located next to the **Race Control building**.

### 17. MEDICAL CENTER

The **Medical Center's location** is indicated on the circuit map (attached).

The **Event Doctor** has the authority to **decide whether a rider is fit** to participate, especially after a fall.

Failure to do so may result in **disqualification**.

#### **18. EVENT INSURANCE**

The event is covered by:

- Civil Liability Insurance (OC) for the event
- Accident Insurance (NNW) for staff and volunteers

The Organizer is **not liable** for:

- Any **damage or loss** to participants or their vehicles
- Damage caused by participants to third parties or their property

By registering, each participant **acknowledges and accepts** they are **competing at their own risk** and **waives any claims** for damages arising during the event.

This waiver applies to:

- The Organizer
- Event officials
- Other participants

### 19. PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

By participating in the event, each competitor **gives consent** to the processing of their personal data for the purpose of organizing the event and to the **publication of photos**, **videos**, **and results** on the organizer's websites.

Each participant has the right to:

- Access their data
- Correct their data
- Request to stop the processing of their data

⚠ Requesting to stop processing data is equivalent to withdrawing from the competition.

### **20. FINAL NOTES**

• Quiet hours apply from 22:00 to 06:00

Failure to comply with noise restrictions during quiet hours (confirmed by a security note) will result in a  $\leq 230$  fine for the rider responsible.

- All fines must be paid no later than 30 minutes before the next session (training or race), or the rider will not be allowed to start
- Each rider is entitled to:
  - o **4 wristbands** (1 for the rider, 3 for accompanying persons)
  - 1 car pass

Extra wristbands can be purchased at the Race Office:

Wearing the wristband at all times is mandatory — lack of a wristband will result in removal by security.

- A fee of **€15** will be charged for each **camper or trailer** staying at the venue
- Leaving used tires on the premises is strictly prohibited and may result in a fine up to €700
- Pets must be kept on a leash in the paddock
  - Pets are strictly **forbidden inside the depot area**
- The Organizer reserves the right to issue **additional communications** and make **official interpretations** of this regulation

### ANNEX 1 - ORGANIZATIONAL INFORMATION

- 1. **It is forbidden to drill holes** into the paving stones in the paddock area.
- 2. Penalties for violating regulations or site rules (for the rider or team members):
  - o **Burnouts on premises** €150
  - o **Disturbing quiet hours** €230
  - o **Drilling into paving stones** €15 per hole
- 3. **Venue entry times**:
  - o Aug 8 (Friday): 06:00 24:00
  - o Aug 9 (Saturday): 06:00 24:00
  - o Aug 10 (Sunday): from 06:00

## One entry allowed between 24:00 and 06:00

- 4. The venue must be vacated within **4 hours** after the final race.
- 5. **Passenger cars** must be parked in designated lots **outside the paddock**.
- 6. A **catering tent** will be open near the paddock during the event.
